



ROAST GOOSE WITH POTATOES AND BRAISED RED CABBAGE

INGREDIENTS:

PROCEDURE:

- Goose about 5 to 6kg
- 2 White onions peeled and quartered
- 2 Apples peeled, cored, and quartered
- 2 Bay leaves

1

- 100ml Red wine
- 500ml Chicken broth

- 6pcMedium-sized potatoes cut in wedges300gPeeled chestnuts
- 300g Braised red cabbage
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste Fresh thyme (optional) small bunch

• Heat oven to 350º F.

- Wash and dry the goose, like you would a chicken or turkey. Salt and pepper and sprinkle thyme inside the cavity, and fill with bay leaves, apple quarters, and onions. If they don't all fit, you can cook them alongside the goose in a small, buttered dish.
- Mix 1 tablespoon salt with 1 cup of water and pour that into the roasting pan. Place the roasting rack on top. Pierce the goose skin in several places to let the fat drip out as it cooks.
- Put the goose, breast-side down, on the roasting rack and place in oven for 50 minutes. Use the salt water mixture to baste

- the goose several times during this period. Add more water to drip pan if necessary. Turn the goose over onto its back and cook, basting as needed, for 50 minutes.
- Let the goose rest for 5 minutes as you make the gravy.
- To make the gravy: Mix 2 tablespoons of the fat drippings with 2 tablespoons flour in a small saucepan and cook for 1 minute. Gradually add the red wine then the chicken broth, stirring well after each addition. Add salt, pepper, and thyme to taste, strain through a fine sieve. Keep warm.
- Serve with roast potatoes, caramelized chestnuts, and braised red cabbage.






